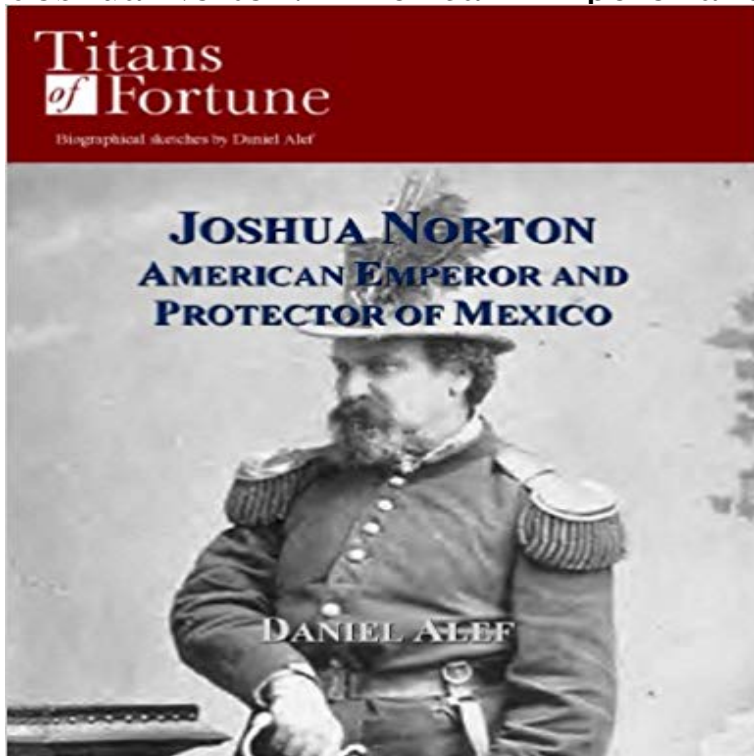


Joshua Norton: American Emperor and Protector of Mexico
