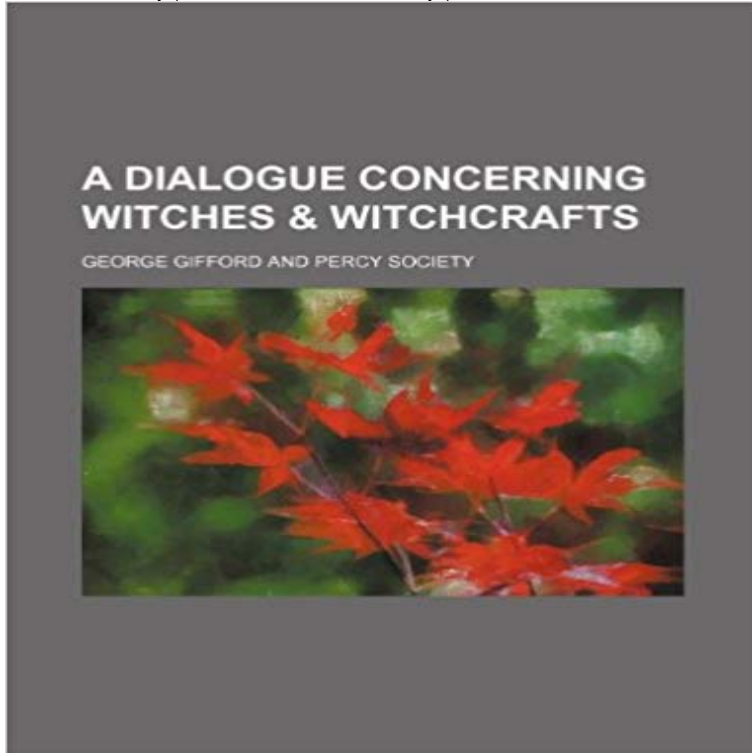

Doe they burne the thing to God, or is it as a verie burnt sacrifice to the devill? In the time of the law burnt sacrifices were ofired to God: the devill among the heathen drewe the like to himself: And now by his sleight he doth after some sort procure the same at their hands, which professe to be Christians, and thus worshipping him, he ceaseth from hurting their bodies, or their cattell, as gaining a greater matter.
