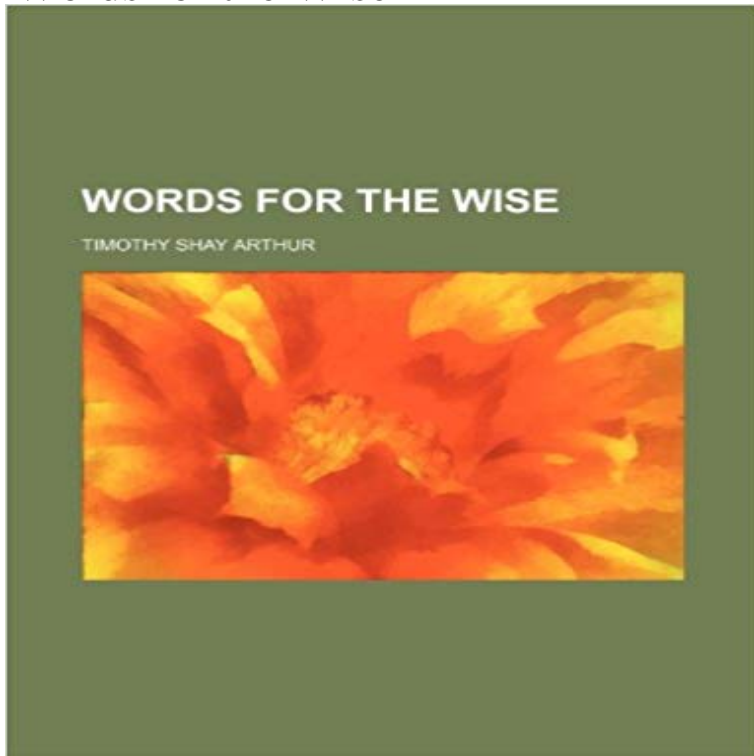

It usually happened that the first hour did not pass after the forming of this resolution without seeing its violation--so strong was the power of habit growing out of an original defect in the mind.
