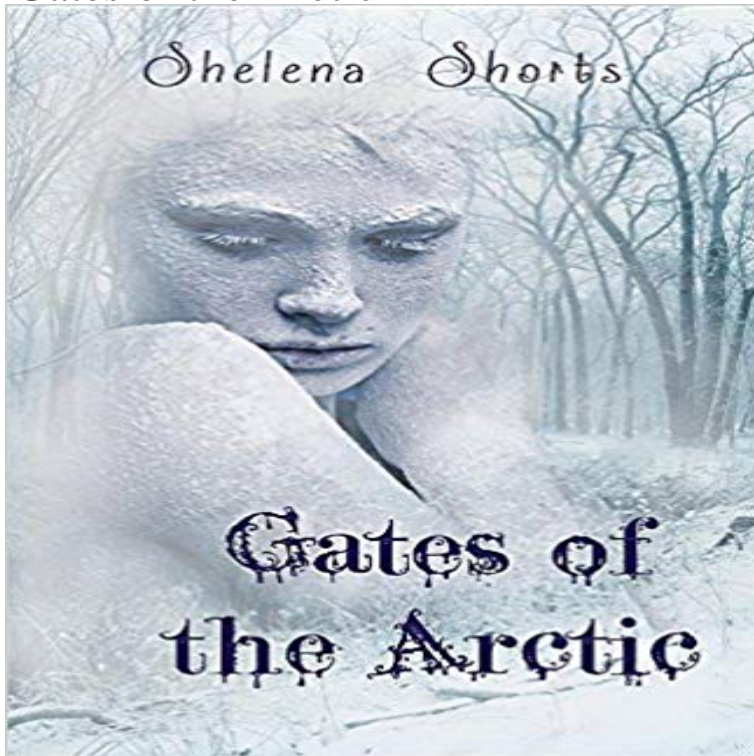


Gates of the Arctic
