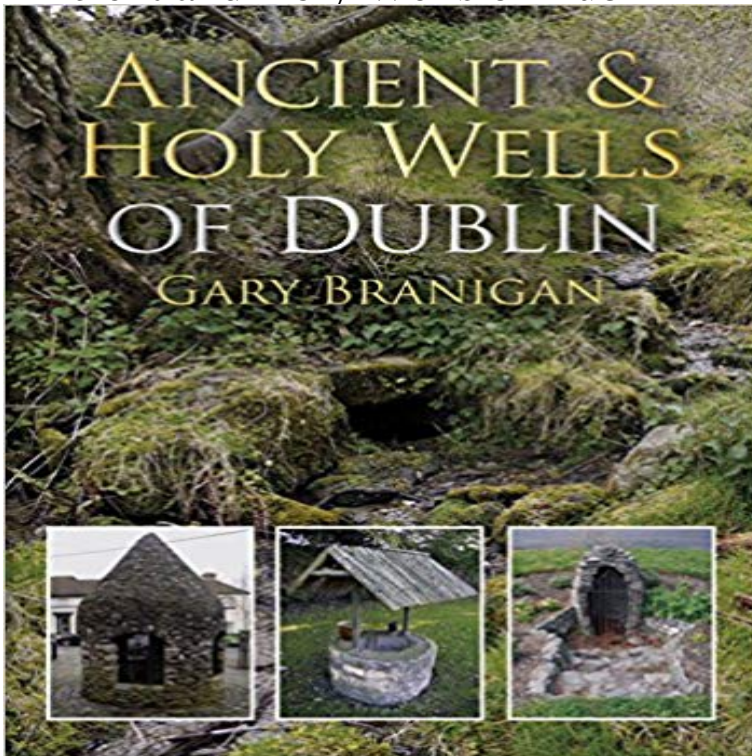


Ancient and Holy Wells of Dublin
