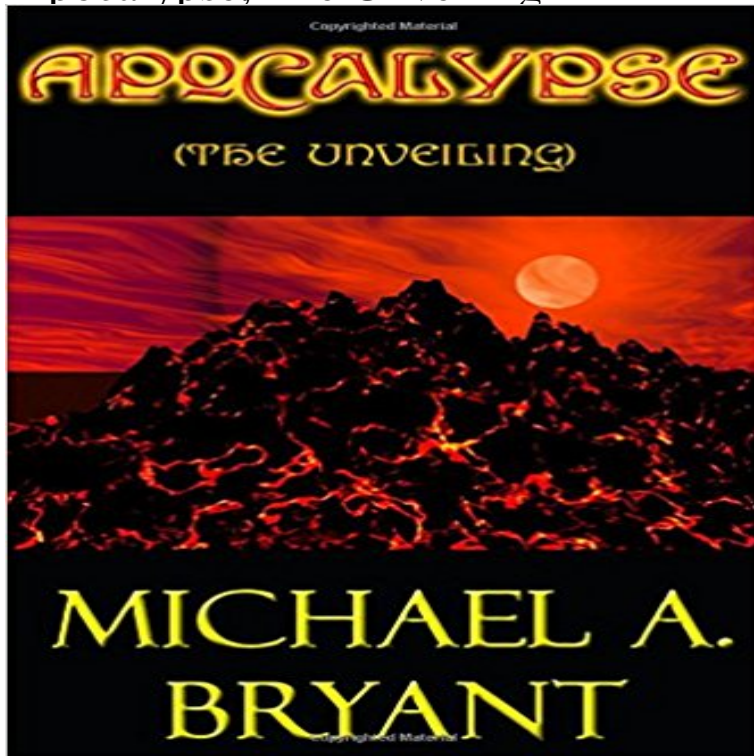


## Apocalypse, The Unveiling
