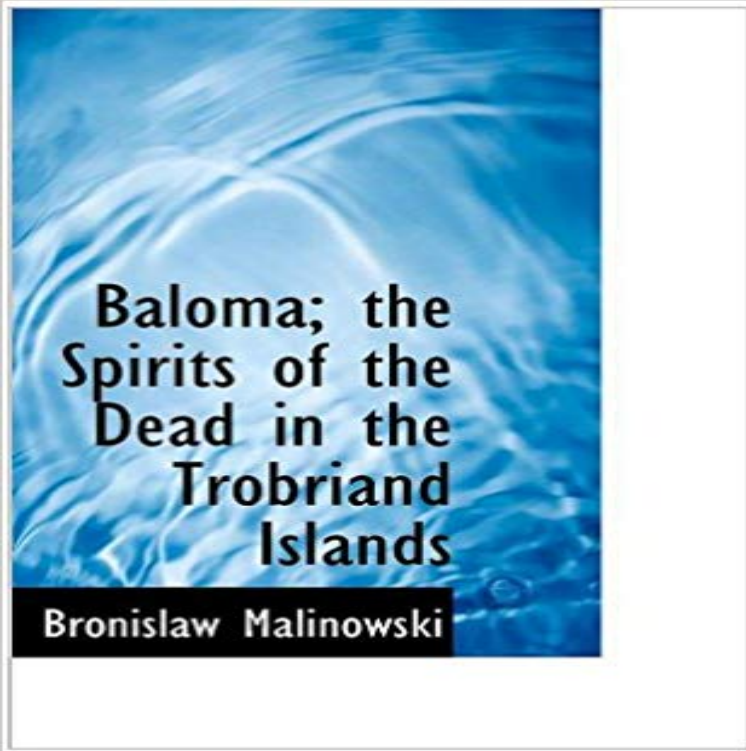


Baloma: The Spirits of the Dead in the Trobriand Islands
