
## Why Buddha Touched the Earth: Zen Paganism for the 21st Century

Over the centuries Buddhism influenced and was influenced by nature religions like Taoism and Shinto, while its introduction to the West came partly through spiritual nature writers like Thoreau and Gary Snyder. Occultists Aleister Crowley and H.P. Blavatsky played key roles in both Buddhist and Neopagan history.
