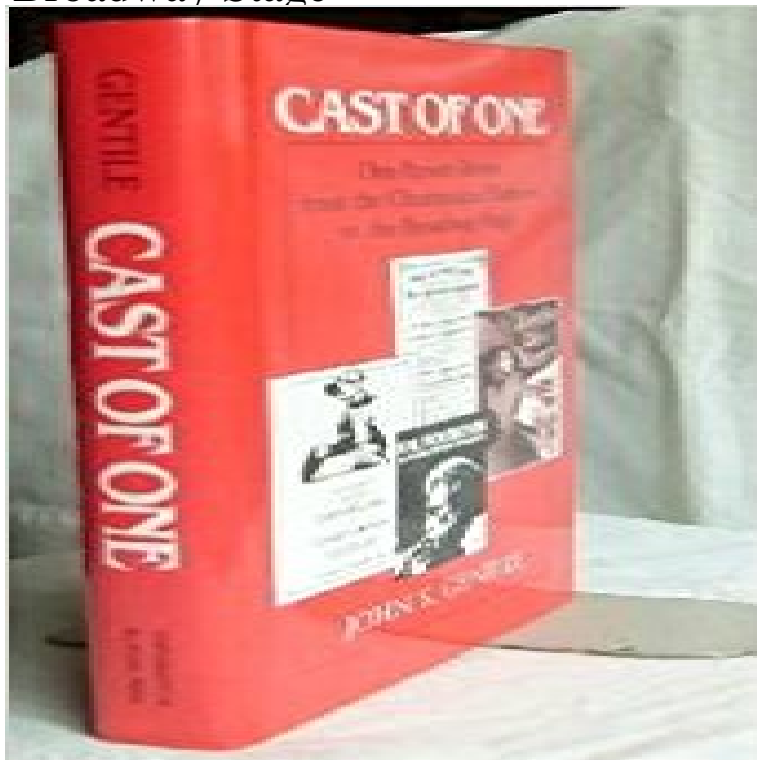


Cast of One: One-Person Shows from the Chautauqua Platform to the Broadway Stage
