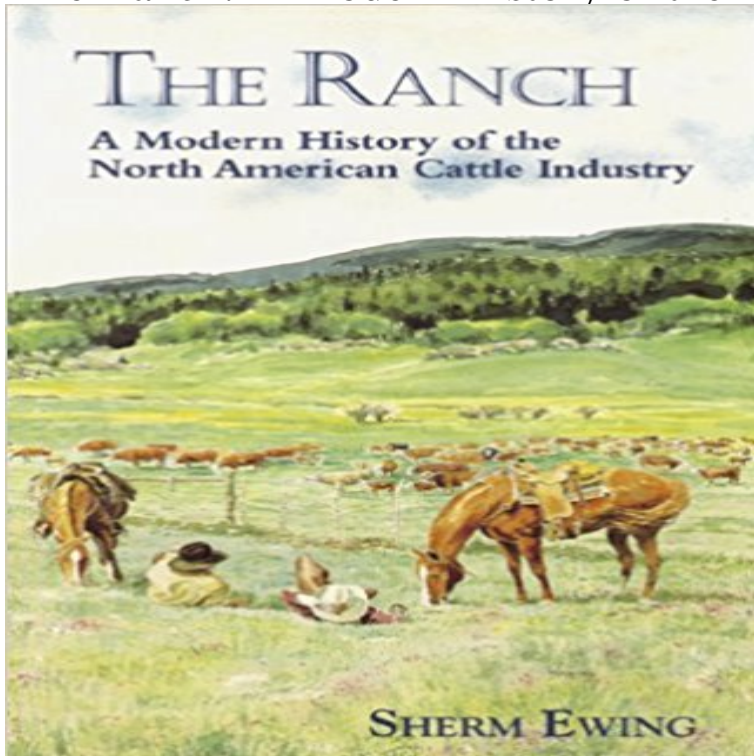


The Ranch: A Modern History of the North American Cattle Industry
