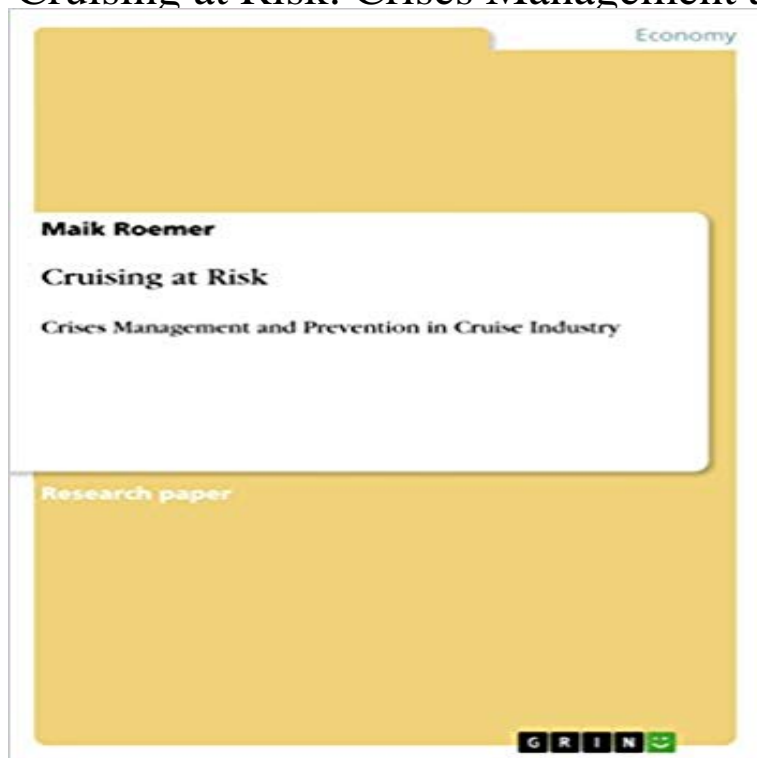


Cruising at Risk: Crises Management and Prevention in Cruise Industry
