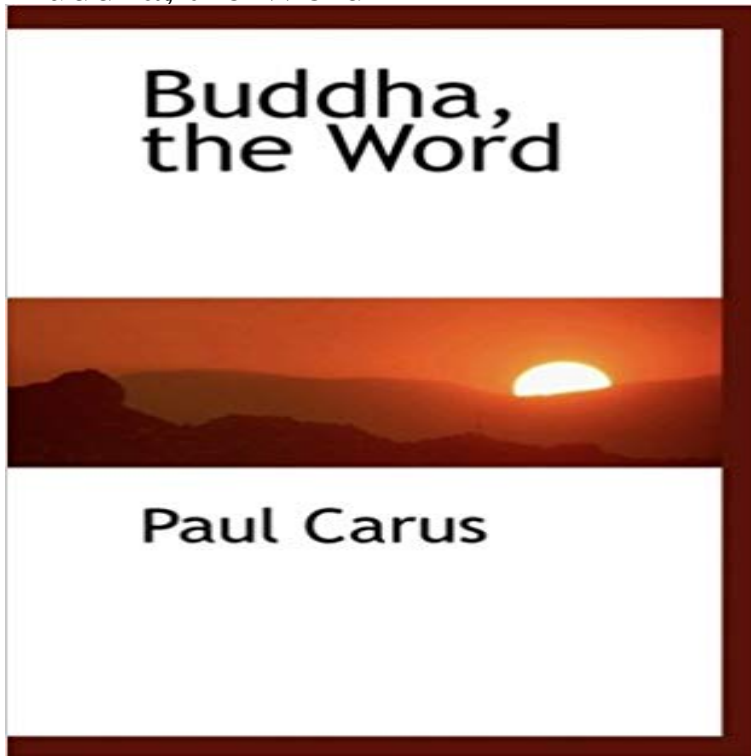


Buddha, the Word
