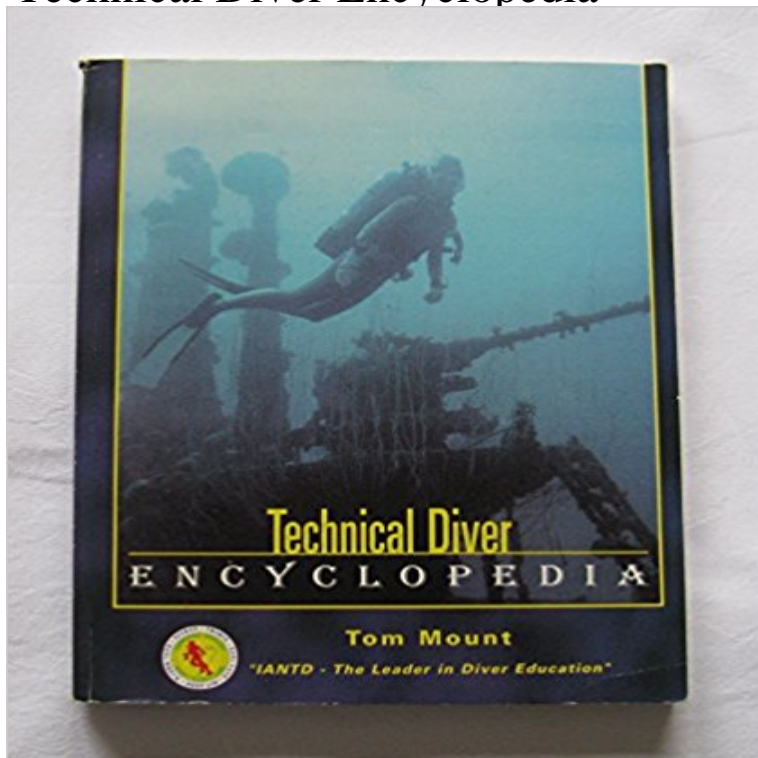


# Technical Diver Encyclopedia
