

Subjects are explored thematically with chapters on the history of religious broadcasting, education, freedom expression, religious practices, marriage and family, and religious institutions. Contentious issues about accommodation are not going away. Fighting over God cites over six hundred legal cases, across nearly four centuries, to provide a rich context for the ongoing social debate about the place of religion in our increasingly secular society.
