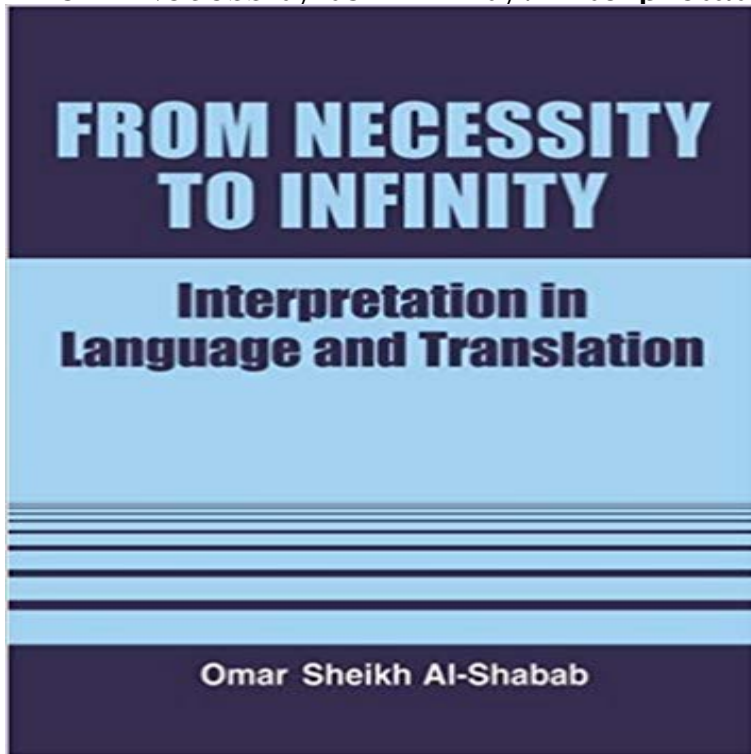


# From Necessity to Infinity: Interpretation in Language and Translation
