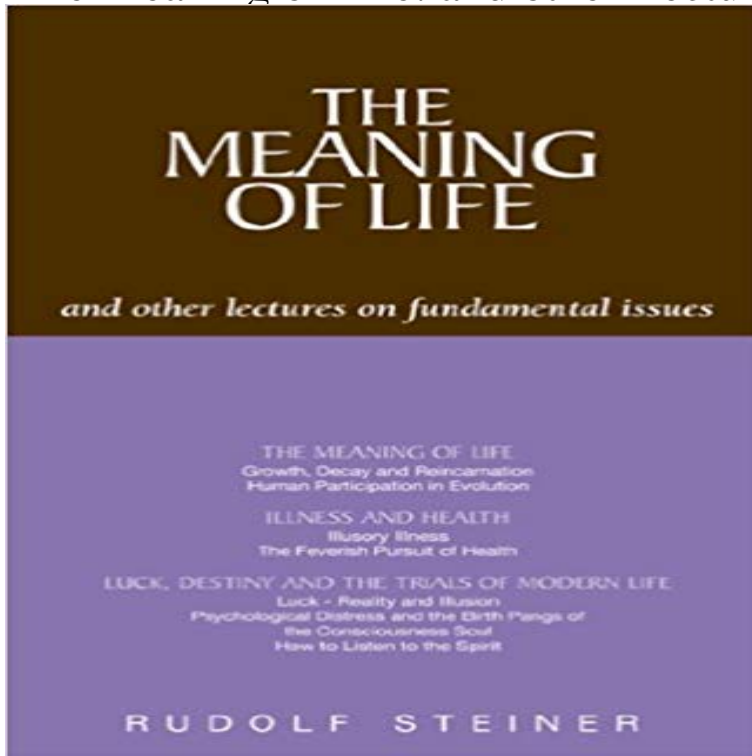


The Meaning of Life: and other Lectures on Fundamental Issues
