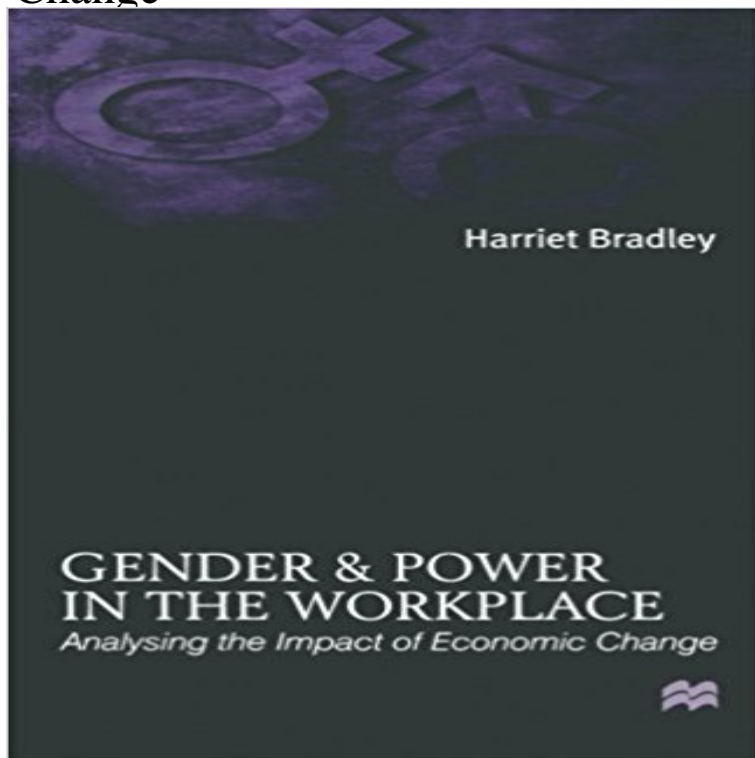


Gender and Power in the Workplace: Analysing the Impact of Economic Change
