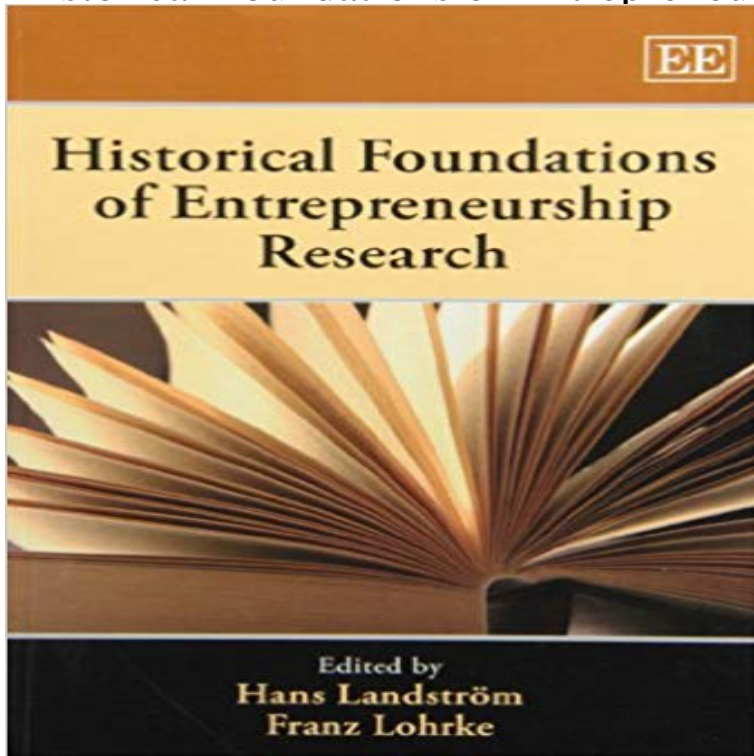


Historical Foundations of Entrepreneurship Research
