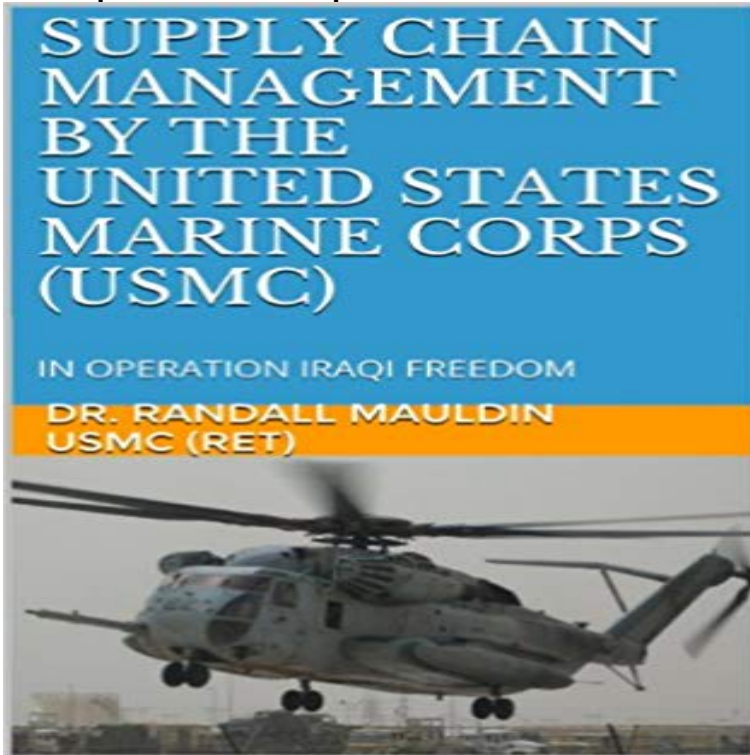


# Supply Chain Management Practices by the United States Marine Corps in Operation Iraqi Freedom
