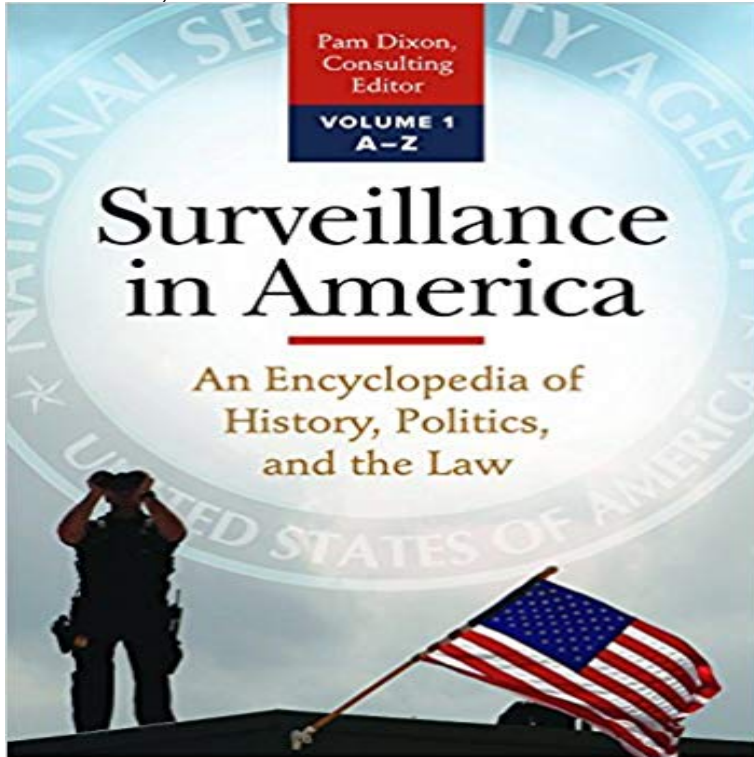


# Surveillance in America [2 volumes]: An Encyclopedia of History, Politics, and the Law
