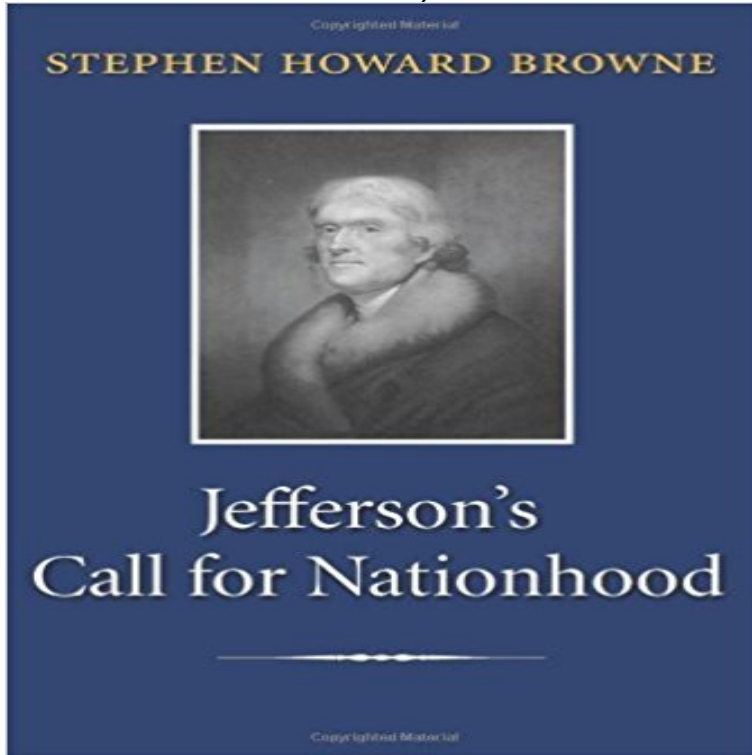


Jeffersons Call for Nationhood: The First Inaugural Address (Library of Presidential Rhetoric)
