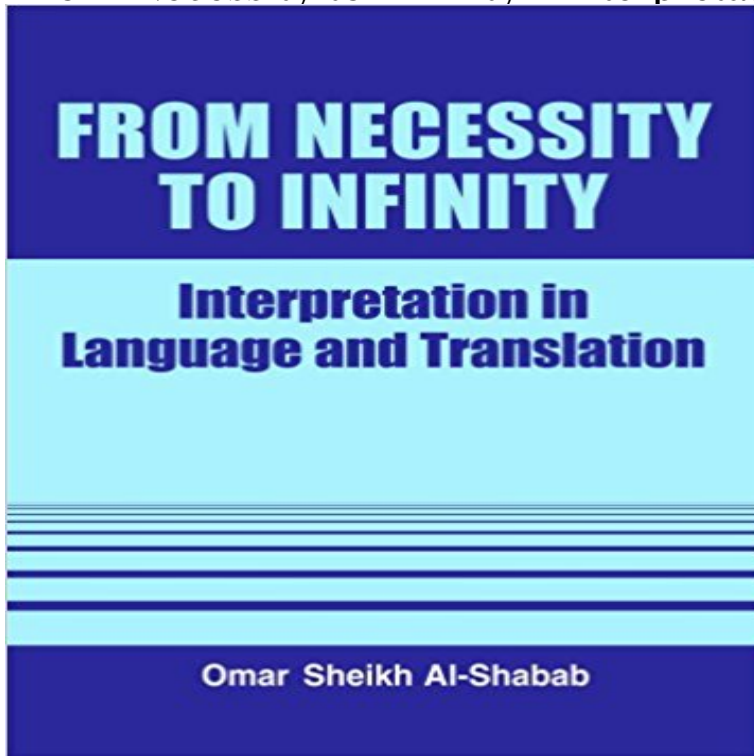


From Necessity to Infinity - Interpretation in Language and Translation
