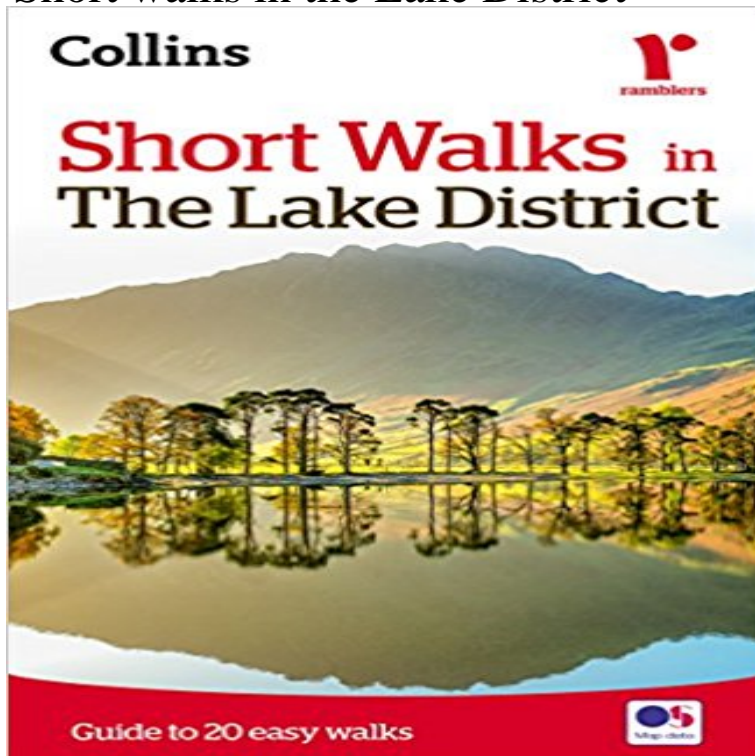


Short walks in the Lake District
