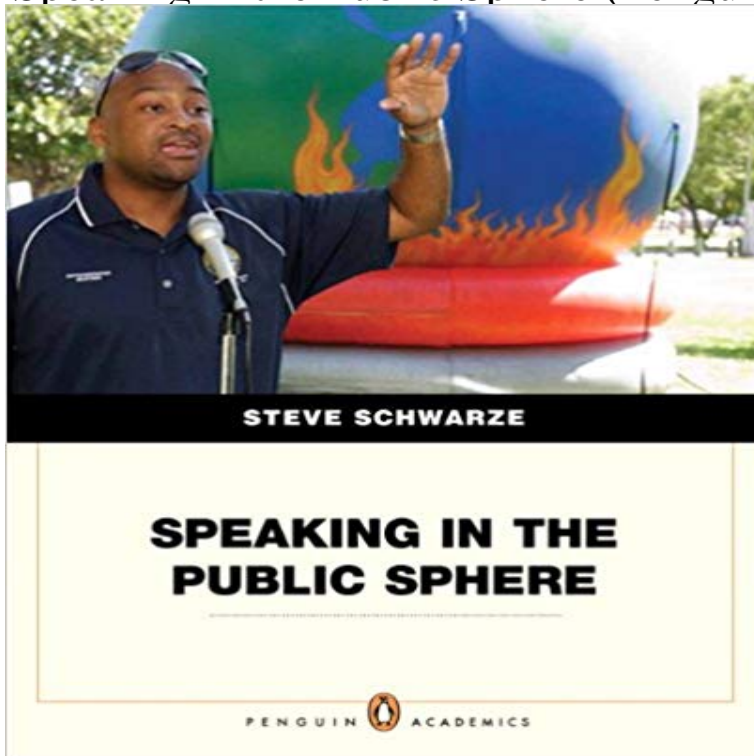


Speaking in the Public Sphere (Penguin Academics)
