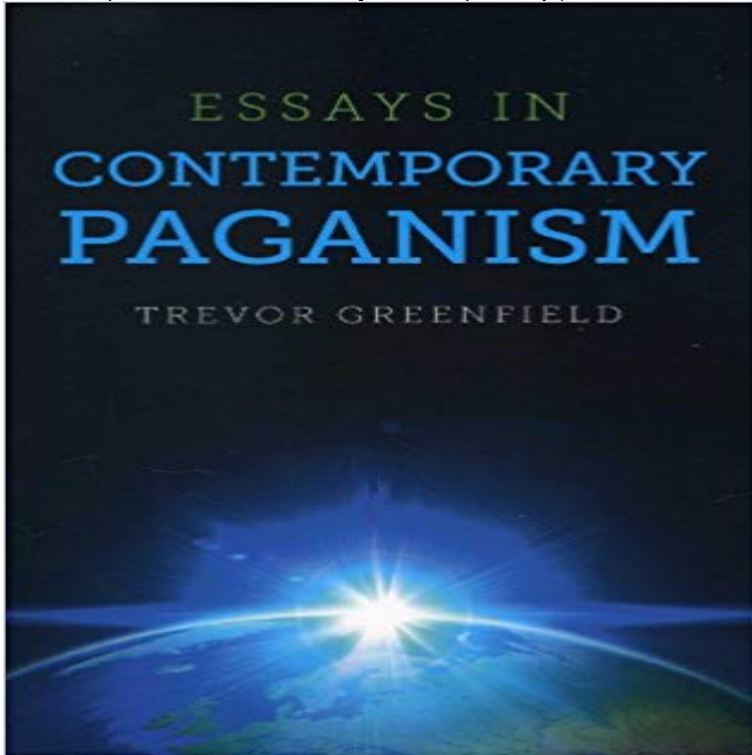


## Essays in Contemporary Paganism
