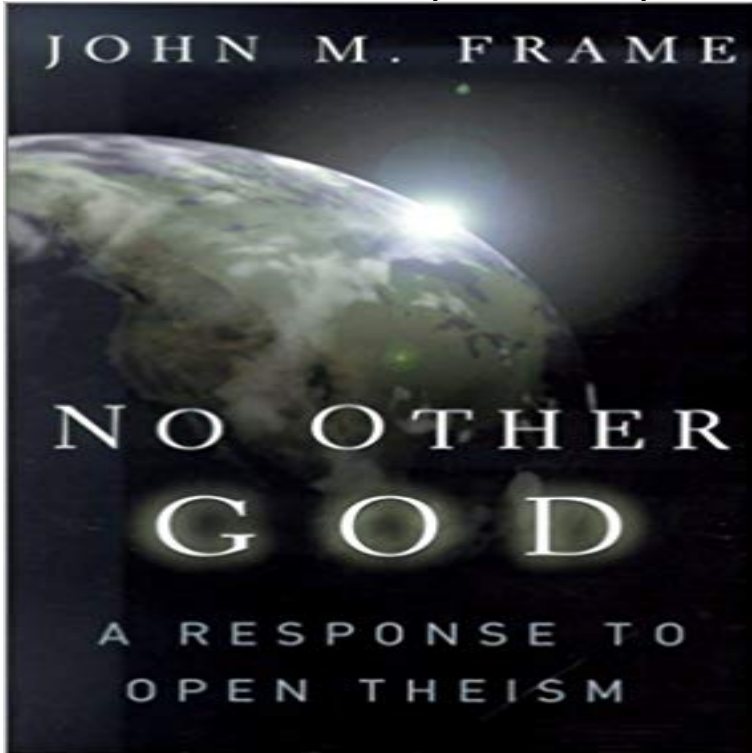


No Other God: A Response to Open Theism
