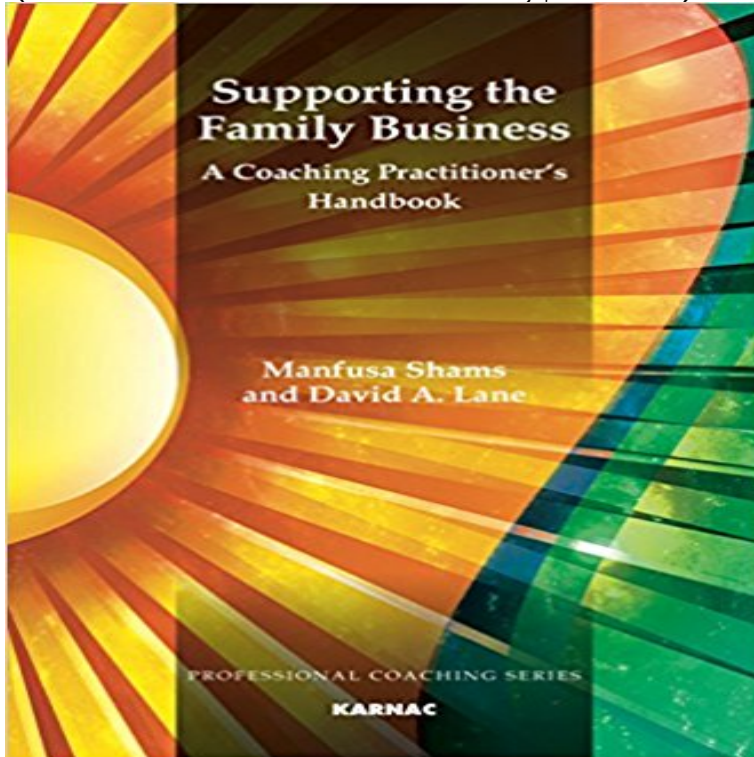


Supporting the Family Business: A Coaching Practitioners Handbook (The Professional Coaching Series)
