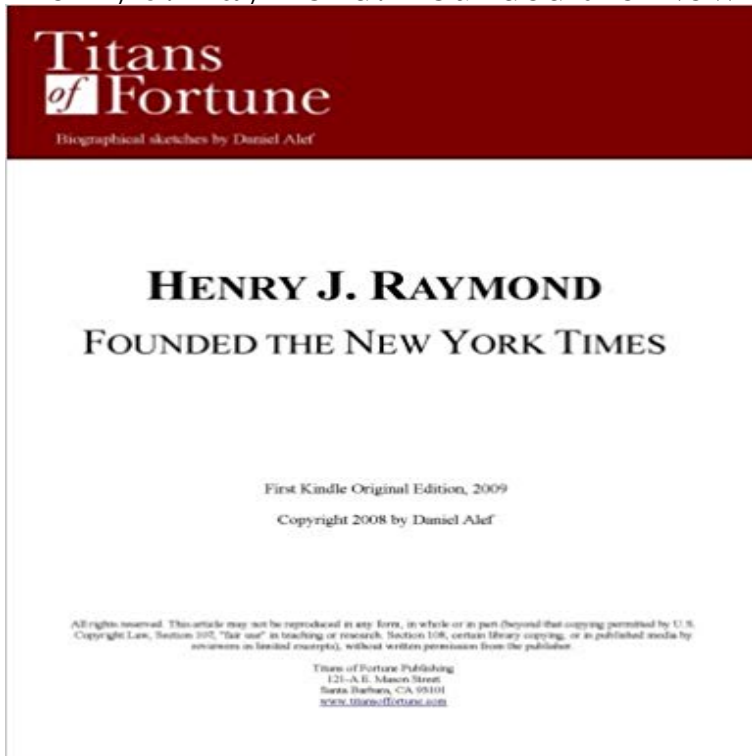


Henry J. Raymond: Founded the New York Times

Raymond was its editorial light, the man most responsible for nurturing the paper from birth to the higher echelons of American journalism.
