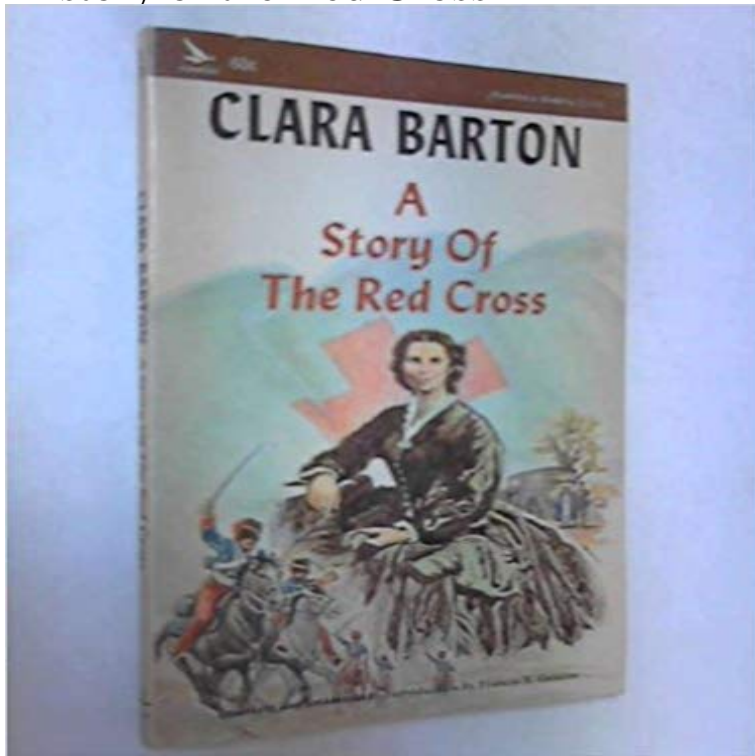


A story of the Red Cross
