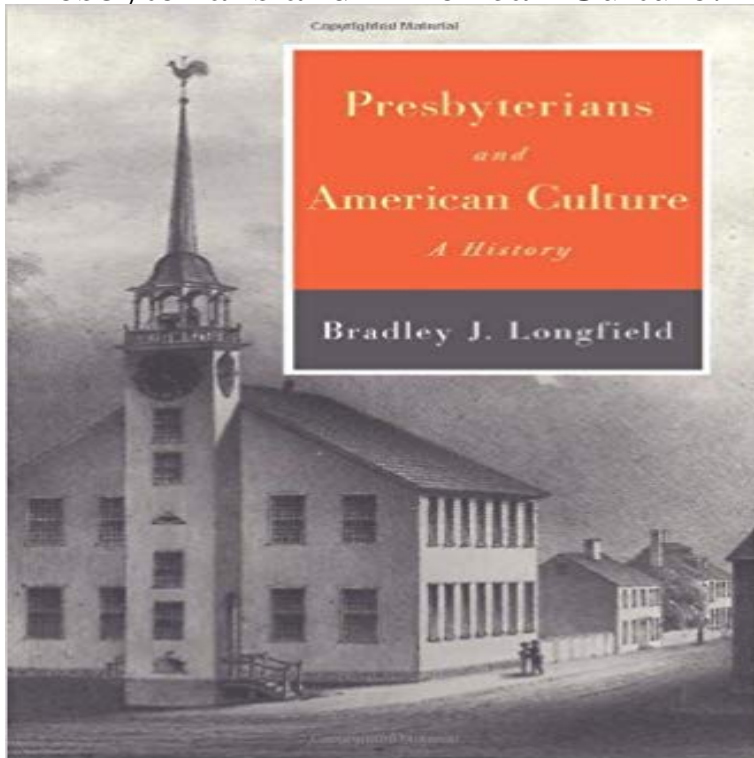


Presbyterians and American Culture: A History
