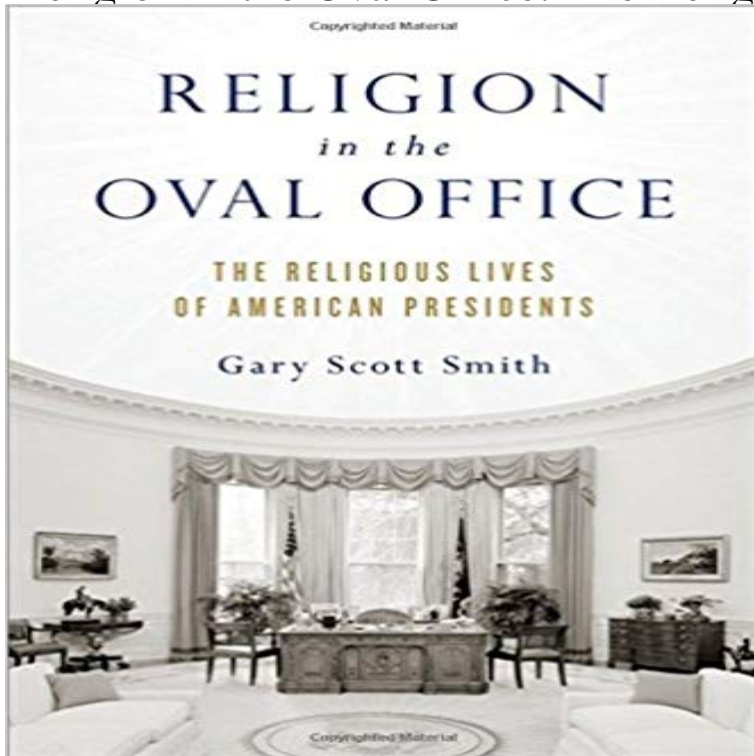


Religion in the Oval Office: The Religious Lives of American Presidents
