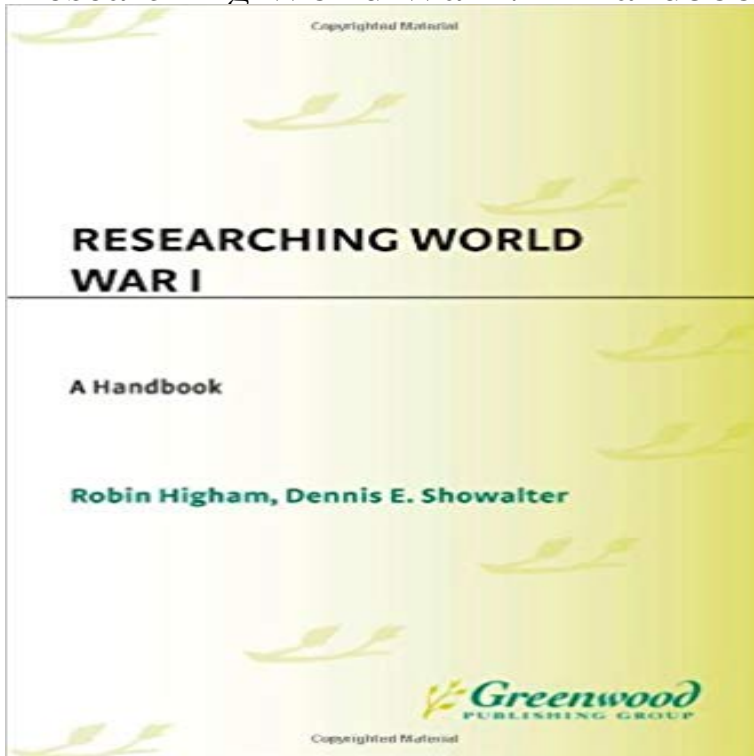


Researching World War I: A Handbook
