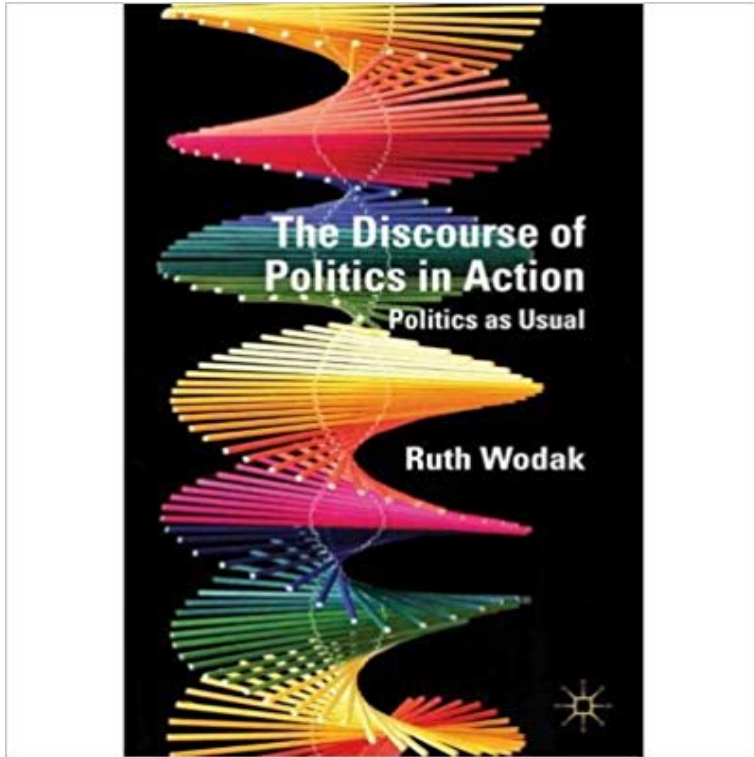


The Discourse of Politics in Action: Politics as Usual (Paperback) - Common
