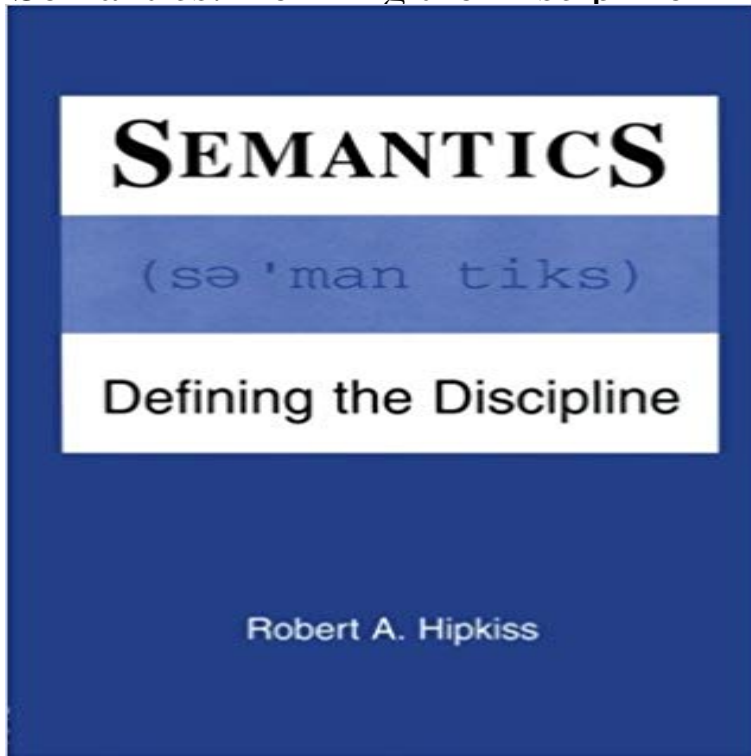


Semantics: Defining the Discipline
