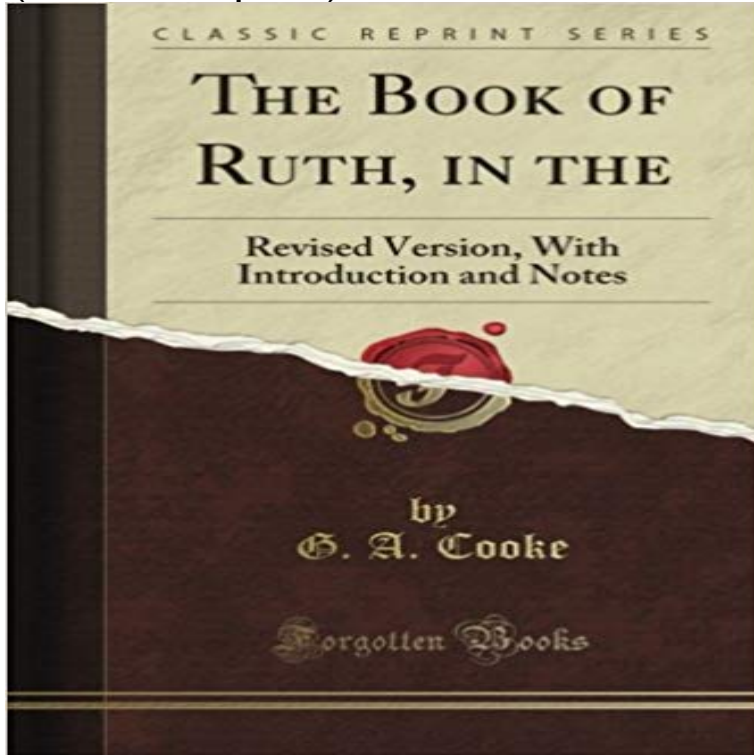


## The Book of Ruth, in the: Revised Version, With Introduction and Notes (Classic Reprint)
