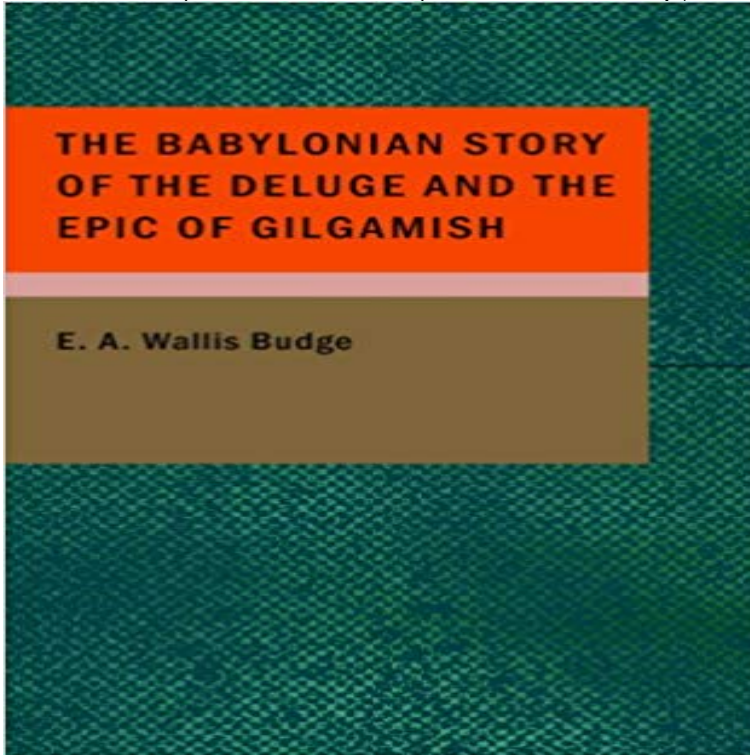


The Babylonian Story of the Deluge and the Epic of Gilgamesh
