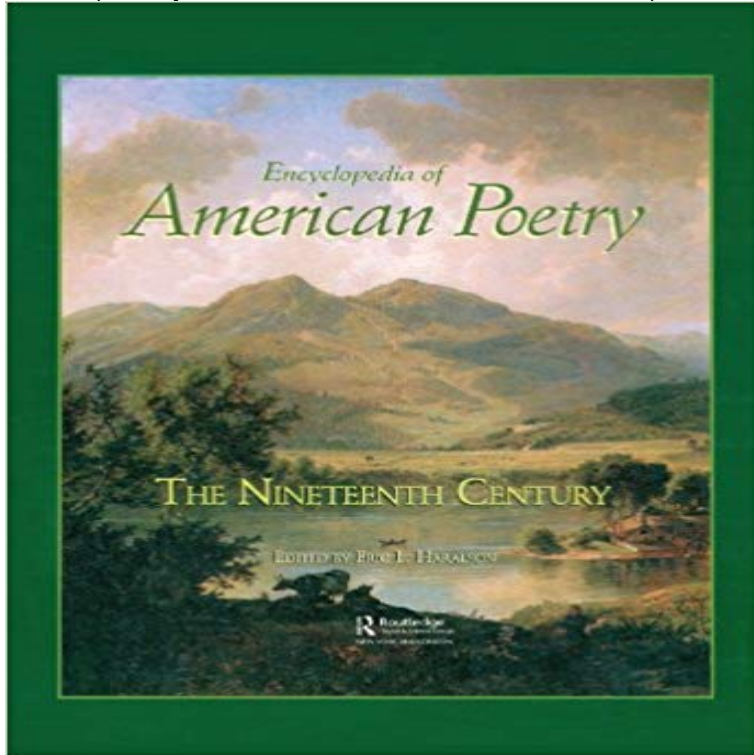


Encyclopedia of American Poetry: The Nineteenth Century
