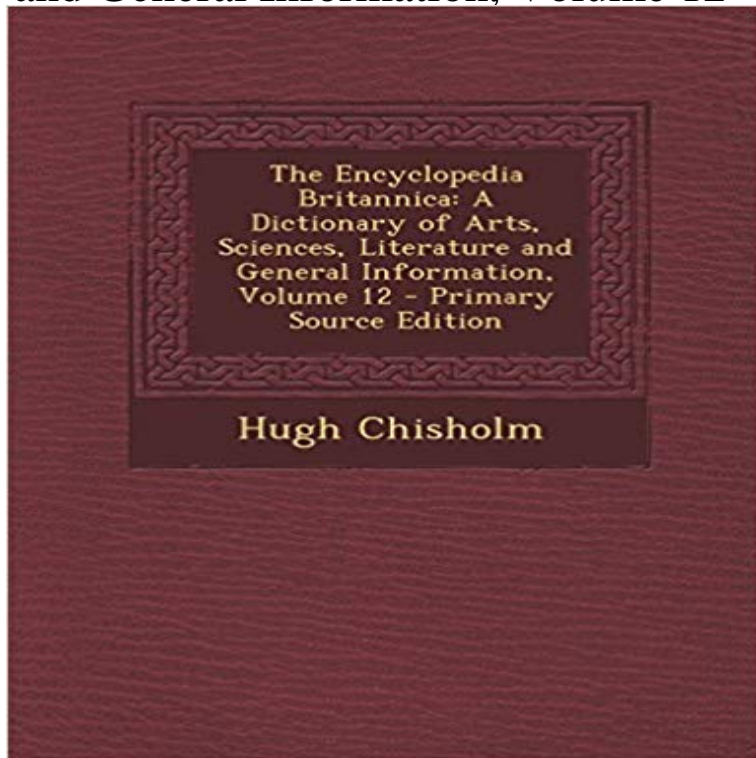


The Encyclopedia Britannica: A Dictionary of Arts, Sciences, Literature and General Information, Volume 12
