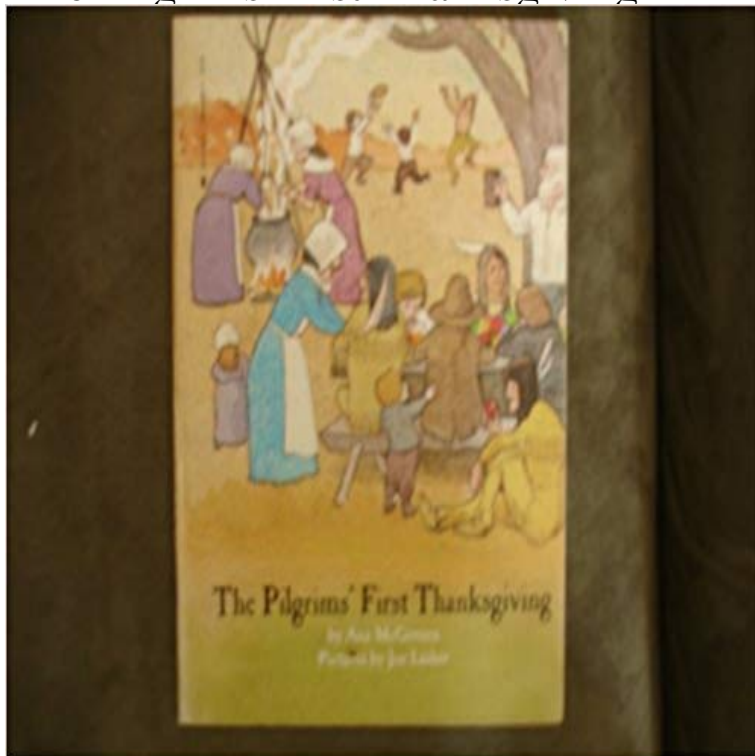


The Pilgrims First Thanksgiving
