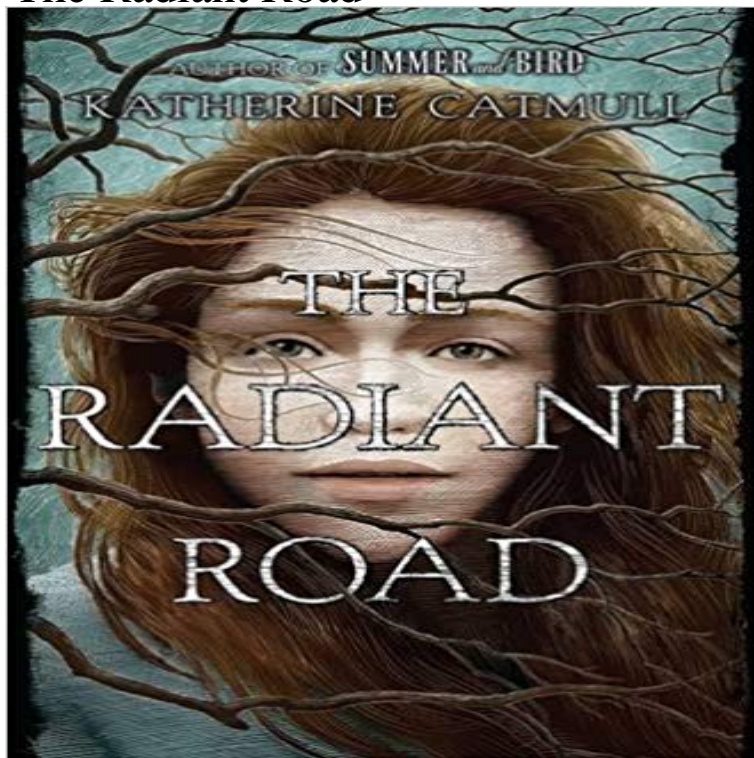


The Radiant Road
