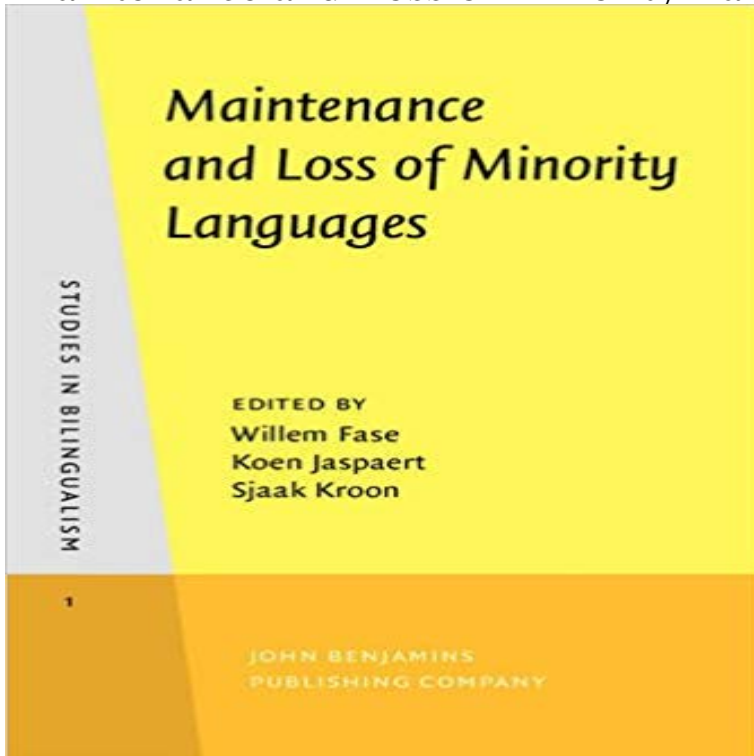


# Maintenance and Loss of Minority Languages (Studies in Bilingualism)
