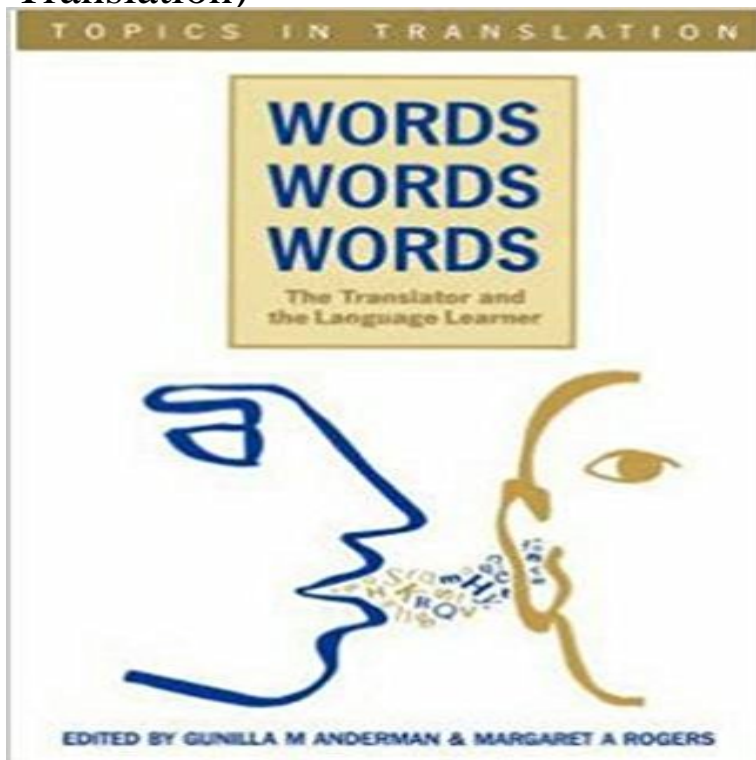


Words, Words, Words. The Translator and the Language (Topics in Translation)
