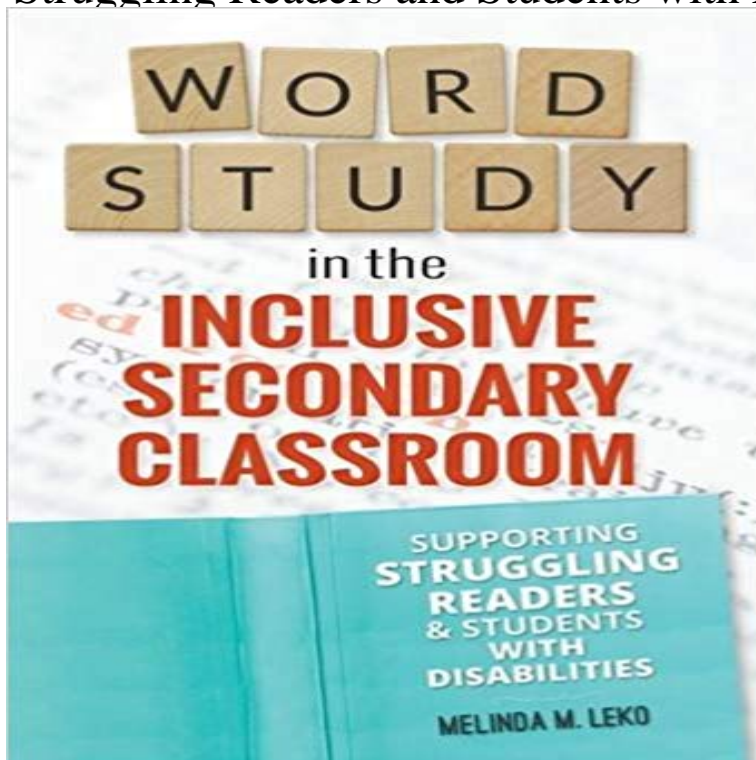


Word Study in the Inclusive Secondary Classroom: Supporting Struggling Readers and Students with Disabilities
